An overview of Jim Corbett National Park

Jim Corbett is the oldest national park in India, has the distinction of being visited by many generations of nature lovers since 1939. With the weather that remains idyllic throughout the year in this part of Uttarakhand, makes it truly an ideal destination for both leisure and adventure. A massive 520 sq kilometers, this includes diverse terrain from the gurgling rivers, to steep hills and of course dense forest host to a wide array of wildlife including Tiger, Elephants, Leopard, Jungle Cat, Nilgai, Sambur etc and over 500 species of resident and migratory birds .

The best opportunity for viewing game is in the early morning and late afternoon and The Park operates four-wheel drive open top jeeps or canters for these excursions. Safaris are led by Jim Corbett Forest Authorities appointed guides who take guests on one of a range of routes through the park. Excursion times are set by the park authorities as only a limited number of vehicles are permitted inside the park core at any one time. The permits are issued 45 days in advance on first come first serve basis.

Timings

Daily Safaris in open-top gypsies or canters depart the resort early in the morning, and again in the afternoon. The Morning safari leaves the camp at 06h30 and returns between 09h30 and 10h00. The second safari leaves the camp at 14h30 and returns between 17h30 and 18h00. Safari times may vary slightly pending on the season. Please check with Front Office Host regarding the timings.

Please choose the zones from the below, enabling us to pre-book the authorised Gypsy vehicle approved by the forest office for your Safaris. The Corbett National Park safari charges are subject to change by the Ramnagar Forest Office without any prior notice, hence payable on actual. Permit are issued for limited Gypsy vehicles (30) and Canter safari seats (32 for Dhikala) under each timing, from one month prior dates (mid October to mid June). Offseason July onwards the safari permits are issued one day prior (non refundable in case the park is closed due to heavy rains). Permit fee is payable online as per the availability. No safari is conducted if the permit is not obtained. The resort is not liable for any non availability of safaris or sudden closure of the National Park due to any strikes or heavy rains or any other reasons.

All safari permit fee is non refundable by the Corbett Tiger Reserve, hence the resort is not liable for any refunds or financial exchanges.

Any booking for day visit to Corbett Tiger Reserve (CTR) during rainy season (1st June to 14th October) is provisional and hence all such bookings during this period are done at visitor's risk and no refund can be claimed from CTR if it is cancelled due to bad weather conditions.

The permits are issued 45 days in advance on first come first serve basis.

(Mid-November to Mid-June)**
